

Now that you will no longer be attending school here at Mercy you will find instructions below on how to uninstall all of the Mercy related software on your tablet that you will no longer need. It is not required that you remove this software, but it may make it easier to use your tablet in other environments if you plan to do so.

Also, please keep in mind that your Mercy Google and network login accounts, as well as the contents of your H: drive will be deleted after August 1st, 2015.

Instructions for removal of Mercy related software:

- Hit your Start button and go to Control Panel
- Double click on Add or Remove Programs.
- Highlight Novell Client for Windows and hit remove, follow the prompts to uninstall.
- Highlight Novell iPrint Client and hit remove, follow the prompts to uninstall.
- Go to Device and Printers right click on any school installed printers and select remove device.
- Reboot your tablet. When it comes back up you will now see the Windows 7 login.

It is also recommended that you find an anti-virus solution. Sophos Endpoint Security will continue to run and update on your tablet, but you will not have any support if something should go wrong with it. It is recommended that you uninstall Sophos once you obtain a new anti-virus product. You may also delete any Mercy related shortcuts on your desktop.
